Deckhand Orientation, Safety and Injury Prevention Training Program - gives each student a general idea of life and safety issues as a Deckhand in the Marine Transportation Industry. Upon successful completion of course, each student is issued a certificate of completion. The student information is then stored in our database.

TWIC Card Pre-enrollment – we will provide you with a pre-paid card or pre-payment to be given to the TWIC office at time of your appointment. We will also schedule you a time and date for your TWIC appointment.

MMC Consultation – we will provide you with all the necessary forms and information you will need to file your completed Merchant Mariners Credentials application to the USCG regional processing center.

Resume Blaster – we will utilize our Resume Blaster software program to present your resume to over 200 Maritime Companies.

In addition you must provide proof of your appeal to our office at the address above via USPS certified mail return receipt showing the dates that you applied and/or any denial letters from any of the governmental agencies within 12 business days excluding weekends and holidays of the date of the denial letters. You must also start the appeal process within the first 10 business days excluding weekends and holidays after receipt of the denial letter from the governmental agency and provide proof of your appeal to our office at the address above via USPS certified mail return receipt.
